

NW Grapes Order Form 2010

This order form is supplemented by information available on the Nanaimo Winemakers website, under “Grapes and Supplies.” See: <http://nanaimowinemakers.org> and start with “Grapes and Supplies.” In particular, see the page on “Vineyards and Varieties: likely sources for grapes in 2010.” If you need more information about how NW Grapes operates, there is also a FAQ page, as well as a page that shows the extent of grape orders so far.

A **deposit for 50%** of the estimated total cost must accompany this order. (The cheque should be made out to “NW Grapes” and mailed to Rod Church, 1411 Marina Way, Nanoose Bay, BC, V9P 9B8.) You will be asked to pay the rest of the estimated cost in advance about September 1, once we have a better understanding of what final prices are likely to be. Your place on the priority list for grapes is determined by the date your order with deposit is received.

With the exception of Gewurz (which arrives as fresh grapes), the unit for orders is the 23L pail containing approximately 20L of settled white juice or red de-stemmed must (equal to about 80 lbs of fresh white grapes or about 50 lbs of uncrushed red grapes). These pails **arrive frozen in Nanaimo**. Local freezer storage will be available at additional cost.

NOTE: Price estimates are just that at this point, estimates. We don’t even know all the final grape prices yet, let alone the exchange rate. Better estimates will be available for your September invoice. Final prices may vary. Typically, people get some money back at the end of the season. NW Grapes is a non-profit operation primarily for the benefit of the Nanaimo Winemakers club and secondarily for the benefit of other BCAWA affiliated clubs. **You must be a member of a BCAWA-affiliated club to order.**
